

Introduction

The year-3 will be assessed in 3 blocks

- 1) Block-G (Foundation 2 and Infection and Inflammation modules) will be assessed in paper-G
- 2) Block-H (Multisystem, blood and MSK modules) will be assessed in paper-H
- 3) Block-I (CVS and Respiratory module) will be assessed in paper-I
- 4) Each written paper consists of 120 MCQs and
- 5) Internal assessment will be added to final marks in KMU as shown in table below.
- 6) In OSPE, each station will be allotted 6 marks, and a total of 120 (plus 10% marks of internal assessment) marks are allocated for each OSPE/OSCE examination

Practical assessment will be in the form of OSPE/OSCE which will also include embedded viva stations. The details of each section are given in the tables given below.
