Experience: Two years teaching experience as Demonstrator /lecturer before or after level II b qualification or one-year teaching experience as Demonstrator / lecturer before or after level III qualifications will be preferred.

Publication: Two Publications in the relevant subject will be preferred

		<p>a. For Clinical Subjects MBBS Degree, and higher diploma such as FCPS, MRCP, FRCS, American Board qualification or equivalent qualification. PMC registration is required prior to interview.</p> <p>b. For Basic Science Subjects, either Ph.D. in the relevant subject from a reputable University or FCPS in the relevant subject registered with PMC/ HEC. If a candidate with above qualifications is not available then MBBS with M.Phil degree in the relevant subject should be considered.</p> <p>c. In Specialties/ Super-Specialties only the candidates with major diploma like FCPS, FRCS, MRCP or MD, CCST (Level-III qualification) in respective specialties will be eligible. Where such candidates are not available in super-specialties then Minor Diploma with minimum of 01 year duration (Level-II qualification) by a recognized university/ PMC will be eligible.</p> <p>d. Experience means the experience gained in a regular full time as a Faculty/ SPR paid job acquired after obtaining the prescribed qualification.</p> <p>b. Experience gained during appointment on adhoc or contract basis or in officiating capacity notified by the Competent Authority.</p> <p>c. The period of training undergone by a candidate for becoming eligible for the award of actual degree/ certificates shall not be counted.</p> <p>d. Only the experience possessed on the closing date of the application shall be taken into consideration.</p> <p>Marks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Marks may be given for teaching experience gained after the minimum experience required for the post @ 03 Marks per year. Candidate without a teaching post in PMC recognized teaching institution in a relevant specialty will get @ 1.5 Marks per year. 	<p>a. Only First or Corresponding Author Research Papers will be considered/ counted in PMC recognized journal.</p> <p>b. Only published articles on or before the last date of submission of application will be considered.</p> <p>c. Marks for the published articles over and above, the articles required for the said post will be counted.</p> <p>d. Candidates must mention the impact factor of each article.</p> <p>e. The candidate should decide which articles should be considered for his/ her basic requirement to the post and which articles for extra marks.</p> <p>f. As per scoring criteria, Marks will be assigned as follows:</p> <p>i. 05 Marks for papers in recognized journals with impact factor > 1.0</p> <p>ii. 02 Marks for the journals with impact factor > 0.3 < 1.0</p> <p>iii. 0.5 Marks for journals with impact factor > 0.1 < 0.3</p> <p>iv. 0.25 Marks for journal in the PMC or HEC list, excluding the ones noted above.</p>	<p>a.
